### **Volunteer position description:** **Investigative Intern**

Investigative Interns are accepted as volunteers while enrolled in college-level coursework in Criminal Justice, Sociology, Psychology or a related field. APD's volunteer program provides exposure to adult and juvenile criminal cases, as well as providing practical investigation experience.

Typical activities of an Investigative Intern:

1. Assist attorneys and investigators with case organization and research.
2. Work with investigative staff in conducting court record checks, serving subpoenas and subpoena duces tecum, obtaining school, medical or other client records.
3. Assist in preparation of demonstrative evidence for presentation in court.
4. Accompany investigators on field interviews and attend court hearings.

**Training:** All new volunteers undergo extensive training, as well as receive on-going mentoring from staff investigators and attorneys.

**Commitment:** A minimum commitment of 12 hours per week, for a period of four months is required.

**Locations:** Downtown central office (Adult Criminal) with branch offices in South Bay, El Cajon, Vista and Juvenile Delinquency office in Kearny Mesa.

**Requirements:** California driver's license, proof of current auto insurance, background check, completion of basic medical screening.
