- 4361 AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO:** Request for approval of Stipulated Abatement Order (filed February 7, 2012) between Petitioner San Diego County Air Pollution Control District and Respondent J. CLOUD, INCORPORATED. Proposed Order allows the continued operation of an approximately 636 horsepower diesel engine, which is certified to Tier 3 standards, to power a jaw crusher at Respondent's stationary facility located at 2094 Willow Glen Drive in El Cajon until October 31, 2012, pending connection to pole power. This prime engine does not have a stationary engine permit and is not equipped with a diesel particulate filter as is required of stationary prime diesel engines.
