- 4407 **HONEYWELL SAFETY PRODUCTS, INC.:** Requests the Regular portion of an Interim/Regular Variance (filed February 18, 2014) from District Rule 21, Condition 2 of its existing District Permit No. APCD2008-PTO-950430 regarding foam products manufacturing and application operation, located at 7828 Waterville Road, San Diego, CA 92154. Petitioner requests to increase its latex usage from 8,000 to 15,000 pounds per day pending evaluation of the risk from increased formaldehyde, toluene diisocyanates, ethylene oxide, acrylonitrile, and 1,4-dioxane emissions.
