- Define Scope/Function/Activity: Provide architectural, engineering and planning services on an as-needed basis for County airports projects.
- Is it more economical and efficient to contract? YES, because of the following factual circumstances associated with this contract: The period of performance is five years. An Economy & Efficiency Analysis was provided for the original contract on June 20, 2006. This amendment is adding additional funding to complete specific Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funded projects within FAA specified timelines and to address significant engineering support service requirements that have developed since the start of the construction of these projects. The services are required on an as-needed basis only. The County does not employ staff trained and experienced to provide all these specialized airport services. The County would need to hire additional full time staff to provide specialized airport related architectural, engineering and planning services such as: redesign of Customs/Border Patrol and TSA areas to provide additional screening rooms and lab facilities to meet new Federal 2007/08 Standards; redesign of parking lots and landscaping to comply with new 2007 Low Impact Development stormwater requirements; design of new stairway for additional pedestrian access to upper level west end businesses; threshold signing and/or relocation, marking and relighting, airport layout plan (ALP) design, airport signage design, helicopter pads including new aircraft run-up areas, perimeter access roads, air traffic control towers, terminal upgrades or design, passenger and pedestrian safety enhancements and general civil engineering tasks. A review of the additional funding and associated work requirements still shows the annual salaries and benefits cost of \$1,118,738 (or \$5,593,690 over the term of contract) is still sufficiently in excess of the total contract price of \$3,250,000 to justify a determination of economy. (Please see table below for summary of potential County staff costs.) Contracting out for the proposed services is more efficient as well in that the contractor has staff available who can provide the needed services on an as-needed basis. Efficiency is further established because it would be inefficient for the County to locate, train, equip and retain professionals with specialized airport expertise that is needed on a fluctuating basis for this type of intermittent or unanticipated additional work.
