4353 AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO: Requests Abatement Order (filed September 01, 2011) against William Lamme (DBA Lamme Kitchens, Inc., Cornerstone Remodeling, Cornerstone Group, Cornerstone Remodel, Countertops or Less, Kitchen Company, Lammes Granite and Tile, Lammes K&BR Granite and Tile, Lammes Kitchen & Bath Remodel, Window World San Diego, Window World Southern California) and Oscar Cerrato (DBA Lamme Kitchens, Inc., Cornerstone Group, Lammes Granite and Tile, Lammes K&BR Granite and Tile, and Lammes Kitchen & Bath Remodel, Cornerstone Remodeling). The requested Order for Abatement is not intended to act as a Variance. The District in this Petition seeks an Abatement Order requiring 1) Respondents to cease operations at 3110 S Santa Fe Avenue, San Marcos and elsewhere in San Diego County until District grants permission to operate; and 2) Respondents to comply with permit conditions and District Rules 10, 67.11, and 67.17.

ACTION: WITHDRAWN BY PETITIONER: OCTOBER 20, 2011

4358 GEICO: Requests a 90-Day Variance (filed October 07, 2011) from Title 17 CCR 93115.6 and District Rule 21 as applied to Condition 1 of Permit to Operate Nos. 974418, 974419 and 974420, pertaining to 3 diesel-fueled emergency engines located at 14111 Danielson Street, Poway, CA 92064, that have exceeded the maintenance and testing limit. The Variance requests permission to operate the engines beyond the permitted 20 hours for maintenance and testing (up to 12 additional hours for each of the 3 engines) in calendar year 2011. A September 2011 power outage revealed defective transfer equipment, so additional hours are needed for maintenance and repairs.
