ORDINANCE NO. 10295 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTIONS 72.162.39.5. AND 72.162.39.5.1. TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE AND AMENDING SECTIONS 72.169.74.7. AND 72.169.74.11. OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Sections 72.162.39.5. and 72.162.39.5.1. are added to the San Diego County Code to read as follows:

Section 72.162.39.5. 4S RANCH. The prima facie speed on Camino Del Norte from the San Diego City Limit (near Bernardo Center Drive) westerly to Dove Canyon Road is hereby decreased to and established at 55 miles per hour.


Section 72.162.39.5.1. 4S RANCH. The prima facie speed on Camino Del Norte from Dove Canyon Road westerly to the San Diego City Limit (Rancho Bernardo Road/Lone Quail Road) is hereby decreased to and established at 50 miles per hour.

Section 2. Sections 72.169.74.7. and 72.169.74.11. of the San Diego County Code are amended to read as follows:

Section 72.169.74.7. BONSALL. The prima facie speed limit on Camino Del Rey (County Road B39) from the east line of State Route 76 easterly to the west line of Via Maria Elena is hereby decreased to and established at 50 miles per hour.

Section 72.169.74.11. BONSALL. The prima facie speed limit on Camino Del Rey (County Road B39) from the east line of Via Maria Elena easterly to a point 1,030 feet east of Mile Post 2 is hereby decreased to and established at 45 miles per hour.


