

**ORDINANCE NO. 9260 (NEW SERIES)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY  
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
RELATING TO THE CABLE TELEVISION COMMISSION**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** Sections 630.1 and 630.8 of the County of San Diego Administrative Code are hereby amended as follows:

**SEC. 630.1. CABLE TELEVISION AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS REVIEW COMMISSION.**

There is hereby created and established in the County of San Diego the Cable Television and Telecommunications Review Commission, hereafter referred to in this Article as “Review Commission.”

**SEC. 630.8. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

(a) The Review Commission is an administrative fact finding and review body. As such, it may make investigations, conduct hearings, and render administrative decisions which, if not appealed to the Board of Supervisors within thirty (30) days of their issuance, shall become final and binding upon the parties involved. The Review Commission may investigate, conduct hearings and render decisions concerning any of the following cable television matters:

- (1) License applications
- (2) License transfer requests
- (3) Operator request for waivers
- (4) Consumer complaints
- (5) License contract compliance
- (6) Impact of Federal Communications Commission rules and regulations
- (7) Legislation affecting cable television
- (8) Affirmative Action compliance
- (9) Rate control regulations

- (10) Other related cable television matters
- (b) In addition to the above duties, the Review Commission shall review and report to the Board of Supervisors on technology, regulatory and legal developments in telecommunications.
