Legal Requirements

- Liquid and vapor leaks shall be repaired immediately upon detection. • All leaks found by the operator that cannot be repaired immediately shall be tagged on the machine (with date & time) and recorded on this checklist. • If liquid and vapor leaks can not be repaired immediately because repair parts are not available at the facility, the parts shall be ordered within the next business day of detecting the leak. • Ordered repair parts shall be installed within two business days after receipt.
- If a leak has not been repaired within seven business days after detection, the dry cleaning machine shall not operated without a leak extension from the District. Call (858) 586-2650 and ask for the Senior Duty Inspector to request an extension.
