**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
BY THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT
FOR A SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION AND RENEWAL
OF A FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV – Title V Operating Permits, of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District’s Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to take action on Application No. APCD2010-APP-001216 to renew a federal Title V Operating Permit and for a significant modification. The proposed Title V Operating Permit will be issued to Minnesota Methane San Diego Miramar, for a landfill gas cogeneration facility located at 5244 Convoy Street, San Diego, CA (Permit to Operate No. 971535).

The proposed Title V Operating Permit incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all applicable federal and District requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with all applicable requirements.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed Title V Operating Permit. Written comments concerning the District’s proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on April 22, 2014, and ending on May 22, 2014. Documents relating to the proposed action are available for public review at this address.
