

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE, pursuant to the State of California Health and Safety Code Section 40725, is hereby given of a public hearing on June 29, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board (Board) of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of receiving public comments on and considering adoption of proposed amendments to Rule 24 – Temporary Permit to Operate.

Rule 24 provides, under certain conditions, a streamlined process for sources to obtain a temporary Permit to Operate prior to completion of the permitting process. The proposed amendments will remove Section (d) – Existing Emission Unit, at the request of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Existing permitted equipment and the great majority of stationary sources in the region will not be affected by this change. Upon rule adoption, the owner or operator of existing unpermitted equipment, for which a permit is required under Rule 10 – Permits Required, will be required to apply for, and obtain, a permit prior to the continued operation of such equipment.


Amended Rule 24, if adopted, will be submitted to EPA through the California Air Resources Board for approval as part of the San Diego County portion of the State Implementation Plan for attaining and maintaining air quality standards.

The Board may consider modifications to the proposal, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are also invited. Comments should be addressed to:
