DESCRIPTION: Preferably the title that will be on the Board letter in order that it can be easily identified.

HEARING DATE: Self-explanatory (will be pursuant to publication requirements).

PUBLICATION

REQUIREMENTS: The originating department will specify the appropriate Federal, State, or County Code Sections and specify the publication requirements such as how many days prior to the hearing the notice needs to be published; how many times it needs to be published; whether notices need to be mailed to citizens within proximity of the project (if so, mailing labels need to be submitted). If posting is required, the original affidavit of posting must be submitted to the Office of the Clerk of the Board before the hearing date.

BILLING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE, pursuant to the State of California Health and Safety Code Section 40725, is hereby given of a public hearing on May 11, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board of the County of San Diego, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of receiving public comments on and considering adoption of proposed amendments to Rule 11 – Exemptions from Rule 10 Permit Requirements, and Rule 66.1 – Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations and Other Processes Emitting Volatile Organic Compounds.

Rule 11 provides permit exemptions for equipment, operations, and processes that are negligible sources of air pollutant emissions. The proposed amendments will add a number of new permit exemptions, update the criteria for certain other exemptions, and improve clarity. Upon rule adoption, permits for newly exempt equipment may be retired. Owners/operators of equipment for which a permit is newly required will have up to one year to submit a permit application.

In addition, corresponding amendments are proposed for Rule 66.1. Specifically, a proposed new exemption has been added for solvent cleaning operations (for the clean-up of products, equipment, and general work areas) using 550 gallons or less of solvent per year, facility wide. Cleaning solvents used in amounts at or below this threshold would be exempt from the volatile organic compound limits in Rule 66.1 and exempt from permit requirements pursuant to Rule 11.


Amended Rule 11 and amended Rule 66.1, if adopted, will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to replace existing Rule 11 and Rule 66.1 in the San Diego County portion of the State Implementation Plan.

The Board may consider modifications to the proposal, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are also invited. Comments should be addressed to:
