



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE, pursuant to the State of California Health and Safety Code Section 40725, is hereby given of a public hearing on May 11, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board of the County of San Diego, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of receiving public comments on and considering adoption of proposed new Rule 67.12.1 – Polyester Resin Operations. Proposed new Rule 67.12.1 limits volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions from polyester resin materials and cleaning solvents used in the manufacture of composite products such as aerospace components, synthetic marble products, surfboards, and boats. It will replace outdated Rule 67.12 – Polyester Resin Operations. Rule 67.12.1 also satisfies federal requirements to implement Reasonably Available Control Technology and state requirements for implementing all feasible control measures to reduce VOC emissions.

Proposed new Rule 67.12.1 reflects the development of new, lower VOC content polyester resin materials and cleaning solvents, and updates record keeping requirements and test methods. If adopted, proposed new Rule 67.12.1 will take effect in one year for existing facilities, and existing Rule 67.12 will be automatically repealed at that time. This one year grace period provides time for affected businesses to use their existing inventories of conventional polyester resin materials and then transition to the new lower emitting materials required by Rule 67.12.1. Any future new operations must comply with new Rule 67.12.1 upon startup.

A written analysis comparing the proposed new rule with applicable requirements of federal and local regulations was prepared pursuant to state law and is available upon request.

The Board may consider modifications to the proposal, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are also invited. Comments should be addressed to:
