SUBJECT: SHERIFF - ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION FROM THE SAN DIEGO HALL OF CHAMPIONS (DISTRICTS: ALL)

Overview

County of San Diego Administrative Code Section 66 and Board of Supervisors Policy A-112, Acceptance of Gifts and Donations, permit the acceptance of gifts by the administrative heads of each department in the County, subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors. This is a request to ratify the acceptance of an \$11,000 donation from the San Diego Hall of Champions in July 2015 to fund the Hall of Champions Juvenile Camp for at-risk youth.

Recommendation(s)

SHERIFF

1. In accordance with Administrative Code Section 66 and Board Policy A-112, ratify the acceptance of an \$11,000 donation from the San Diego Hall of Champions for the Hall of Champions Juvenile Camp for at-risk youth held in July 2015.
2. Authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign a letter of appreciation on behalf of the Board of Supervisors and the County of San Diego to the San Diego Hall of Champions.

Fiscal Impact

Funds for this request are not included in the Fiscal Year 2015-17 Operational Plan for the Sheriff's Department. If approved, this request will ratify the acceptance of an \$11,000 donation from the San Diego Hall of Champions in July 2015. 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Background

Early positive contact with law enforcement and the appropriate implementation of intervention programming including camps and diversion programs has been associated with a decreased likelihood of entering the Juvenile Justice System. To help promote that early positive contact with law enforcement, the San Diego Hall of Champions (SDHOC), in partnership with the Sheriff's Department Juvenile Detective Unit, hosted the Hall of Champions Juvenile Camp, a two-day camp for at-risk youth held on July 23 and 24, 2015.

The Sheriff's Department handled the administration of the Hall of Champions Juvenile Camp, while the SDHOC served as the liaison with Balboa Park, secured guest speakers, and provided \$11,000 in funding in addition to the venue and facilities used in the camp.

The Hall of Champions Juvenile Camp allowed the juvenile detectives to provide an opportunity for a positive life-changing experience for at-risk youth in San Diego County. The camp focused on building the character, self-esteem, and social skills of the young people in attendance through inspirational and motivational messages utilizing several unique programs.

Linkage to the County of San Diego Strategic Plan

Today's proposed actions support the Safe Communities and Operational Excellence initiatives of the County of San Diego's 2016-2021 Strategic Plan by accepting gifts and donations used for the benefit of staff providing services to the residents of San Diego County and by publicly disclosing those gifts and donations received by the Sheriff's Department.
