


**MINUTES**  
**CITIZENS' LAW ENFORCEMENT REVIEW BOARD MEETING**  
**June 10, 2014**

- Roll Call**
  - The Board meeting was held at the County Administration Center and came to order at 5:30 p.m. All Board members were present except Calixto Pena and Delores Chavez-Harmes.
- Minutes Approval**
  - The April 2014 meeting minutes were approved by motion.
- Training**
  - *Detention Medical Services and Suicide Prevention* by Doctor Alfred Joshua, Medical Director - Sheriff's Detentions.
- Executive Officer**
  - Patrick Hunter summarized the Investigative Workload & Classification Reports for April and May: As of April 30, 2014, there were **87** open investigations; **14** new complaints received and **11** cases closed.  
In May, there were **100** open investigations; with **12** new complaints received and **1** case closed.
  - Outreach Activities by Patrick Hunter: Board Chair DeLaBarre accompanied him in a presentation to a Yemen delegation sponsored by the San Diego Diplomacy Council. Executive Officer continued to work with the Somali Community-Law Enforcement Roundtable video subcommittee to ensure civilian oversight of law enforcement is included in video materials. Executive Officer has been in contact with Los Angeles County Counsel, Inspector General, and Sheriff's Department, as they research various models of civilian oversight. A CLERB presentation was given to the most recent Sheriff's Detentions Academy.
