- Patrick Hunter summarized the Investigative Workload & Classification Report for July and August: As of July 31, 2014, there were 101 open investigations; 15 new complaints received and 9 cases closed. In August, there were 121 open investigations; with 20 new complaints received and 4 cases closed.

- Riley Gordon: Inquired about shooting ranges, and the use of body worn cameras. Response by Sheriff’s Liaison, Robert Kanaski: 1) The Sheriff’s Dept. is not involved in a day-to-day range operations, unless there is a need for law enforcement response, e.g., a shooting or OSHA violation(s). 2) The Sheriff’s Dept. is currently researching body worn cameras. Deputies are being issued iPhones for use in accordance with Sheriff’s Policy, however, personal video cameras, e.g., GoPro, are currently prohibited until policy is written.
 - Loren Vinson: Inquiry on the use of personal cell phones being used by deputies. Response by Sheriff Liaison, Robert Kanaski: Deputies are not to use personal cell phones for audio/video recording.
