

**NAME:** COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 026 - RANCHO  
SAN DIEGO LOCAL PARK DISTRICT CITIZEN  
ADVISORY BOARD

**LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Resolution No. 37A adopted 6/18/91, Resolution No.  
16-040 adopted 4/27/2016 (7).

**GEOGRAPHICAL  
AREA:** CSA No. 26 is defined as: an area including but not limited  
to, Avocado Park, Woodhaven (Cottonwood II) Park,  
Steele Canyon Park, Cottonwood I, Hilton Head  
(Cottonwood III), Del Parque and Damon Lane parks as  
they are developed.

**MEMBERS  
APPOINTED BY:** Members of the Citizen Advisory Board shall be nominated  
by the Supervisor, District 2, and appointed by the Board of  
Supervisors.

**MEMBERSHIP  
COMPOSITION:** A member of the CSA 26 Advisory Board shall be a  
resident or property owner in the community of Rancho  
San Diego and shall demonstrate an interest in and  
knowledge issues related to the parks. The County  
Supervisor of District Two shall nominate the members,  
and the San Diego County Board of Supervisors shall  
appoint them.

The Advisory Board shall consist of a minimum of three  
members and a maximum of nine members.

Effective January 1, 2017 the Advisory Board shall consist  
of a minimum of five members and a maximum of nine  
members.

**TERMS:** Each member of the CSA 26 Advisory Board shall serve a  
term that runs concurrently with the District Two  
Supervisor.

**DUTIES:** The purpose of the Advisory Board is to provide input to  
the Department of Parks and Recreation regarding the  
annual operations and maintenance budget for CSA 26 –  
Rancho San Diego Local Park District (Cottonwood,  
Damon Lane, Del Parque, Hillsdale Hilton Head, Lonny  
Brewer, Steele Canyon, and Woodhaven) and any sites as  
they are developed within the County Service Area.
