Preamble

Any person designated in Section I of this Appendix who is unsure of any right or obligation arising under this Code may request a formal opinion or letter of advice from the FPPC or an opinion from the Authority's General Counsel. (Gov. Code § 83114, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. § 18730(b)(ii) A person who acts in good faith in reliance on an opinion issued to him or her by the FPPC shall not be subject to criminal or civil penalties for so acting, provided that all material facts are stated in the opinion request. (Gov. Code § 83114(a).)

Opinions rendered by General Counsel do not provide any statutory defense to an alleged violation of conflict of interest statutes or regulations. The prosecuting agency may, but is not required to, consider a requesting party's reliance on General Counsel's opinion as evidence of good faith. In addition, King/Chavez Academy of Excellence may consider whether such reliance should constitute a mitigating factor to any disciplinary action that King/Chavez Academy of Excellence may bring against the requesting party under Government Code section 91003.5.
