

ORDINANCE NO 10441 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE X-A OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE BY ADDING SECTION 160.4 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO NOTARY PUBLIC FEES CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article X-A, Section 160.4 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby added as follows:

SEC. 160.4. FEE FOR NOTARY PUBLIC SERVICES

Except as otherwise provided by law, the fee for notary public services, including, but not limited to, taking an acknowledgment or proof of a deed, or other instrument, to include the seal and the writing of the certificate, and administering an oath or affirmation to one person and executing the jurat, including the seal, is \$15 for each signature taken.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2017. Within fifteen days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
