

Instructions for Completing Bond for a Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling Permit

1. One conformed original of the bond shall be provided to the County. The wording must match exactly the wording on the form provided by the County.
2. Copies of signatures and acknowledgements are not acceptable. If the signer is acting as an officer of a corporation, give title and name of corporation.
3. If the principal is a corporation, the corporate seal must be affixed to the documents.
4. If the signer is acting as a partner for a partnership, indicate “partner” and give the name of the partnership.
5. Notary must witness signature and acknowledgement by the principal and attach notary certificate to the Bond.

The condition of the foregoing obligation is such that whereas said principal has filed or is about to file
with San Diego County an application for a permit to perform construction or demolition work, or both, within the
unincorporated area of the County of San Diego, more specifically described in the application for the permit as

in accordance with the provision of the San Diego County Code.

NOW THEREFORE, if the above named principal shall well and truly comply with all the
requirements of Article II, of Title 6, of Division 8, commencing with Section 68.508 of the San Diego County
Code and if all of the work required to be done complies with all of the terms and conditions of the Debris
Management Plan (DMP) required for the construction and demolition work and the recycling rates required
by the San Diego County Code for the permitted construction or demolition work have been fully achieved
to the satisfaction of the DMP Compliance Officer then this obligation may be released by the Surety in
accordance with Section 68.515 of the San Diego County Code; otherwise, it shall be and remain in full
force and effect.

The said Surety, for value received, hereby stipulates and agrees that no change, extension of time,
alteration or additions to the terms of the DMP, the permit issued for the construction of demolition work or
to the work or improvements to be performed there under shall in any wise affect the obligations on this
bond, and it does hereby waive notice of any such change, extension of time, alteration or additions to the
terms of the DMP, permit or to the work or improvements.

In the event suit is brought upon this bond by the County and judgment is recovered, the Surety shall pay
the amount of any unpaid forfeiture owed County pursuant to Section 68.515 of the San Diego County
Code, all costs incurred by the County in such suit, including reasonable attorney's fees to be fixed by the
Court.
