

GREASE TRAP AGENCIES

Contact your local waste water authority to determine if a grease trap or interceptor is required for your facility. If a grease trap is required, ensure that plans are submitted and approved or approval granted by the local enforcement agencies, including the Department of Environmental Health and the local building authority, prior to the start of construction.
