The County of San Diego is offering a workshop to assist you with CERS!

Effective January 1, 2013, State law changed, requiring all regulated businesses to submit their Unified Program Facility information and business updates electronically, instead of using paper forms.

To comply with State law and avoid violations, businesses must electronically submit required information using the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS).
