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The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and has accepted for filing an application package for a modification to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Evergreen Nursery Oceanside Composting Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed Permit Modification: The operator has submitted an application package to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP). The proposed SWFP modification will provide some administrative updates such as current references to supporting documents and LEA findings, and amend the Report of Composting Site Information (RCSI). The permit modification will not result in an increase of hours of operation or permitted daily tonnage.

LEA Findings per 21660.3: The LEA has reviewed and considered the information, including the environmental effects of modifying this Solid Waste Facility Permit. A recirculated Negative

Declaration SCH No. 19980901015 & 200555061105 (2000) was filed with the State Clearinghouse. No substantial changes are proposed in the project and the LEA determined that the proposed changes are such that the SWFP does not need to include further restrictions, prohibition, mitigations, terms, conditions or other measures to adequately protect public health, public safety, ensure compliance with State minimum standards or to protect the environment.
