Please be advised that the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency received and has accepted for filing an application package for a modified Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Gregory Canyon Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego, excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed Permit: The operator has submitted an application package to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP). The proposed modification will update the SWFP to include the Non-Water Release Corrective Action Plan (a requirement since the SWFP was issued in 2011) and some administrative updates such as: updating the approval block for the new Director of the Department of Environmental Health; making an address correction for the

LEA; referencing the most current Joint Technical Document; Updating Section 13, Findings, to reference the five year Review Report of the County Integrated Waste Management Plan completed in September 2012; and, referencing the most current date for the Operating Liability Insurance. The permit modification will not result in an increase to operating hours or permitted daily tonnage. The proposed modified SWFP will not allow the landfill to initiate construction or start operations as there are other separate approvals from local, state and federal agencies required.

LEA Findings per §21660.3: The LEA has reviewed and considered the information, including the environmental effects of issuing this modified Solid Waste Facility Permit, for the Gregory Canyon Landfill. The Environmental Impact Report (EIR) required by CEQA (state law) for the project has been completed and certified. The LEA has determined pursuant to section 15162 of the CEQA Guidelines that the proposed modifications to the solid waste facility permit are not a basis for requiring supplemental environmental analysis. A federal Environmental Impact Study (EIS) is also being prepared by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
