Please be advised that the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding an informational public meeting in compliance with Public Resource Code §44004(h) regarding a revised proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit for Palomar Transfer Station, SWIS #37-AH-0001. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities.

Palomar Transfer Station is an existing municipal solid waste transfer facility with a tipping area of 19,470 square feet located at 5960 El Camino Real Carlsbad, CA 92008. On August 7, 2015 the LEA accepted for filing an application package for a revised Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) from Republic Services to allow for a proposed building expansion of the Palomar Transfer Station.

The revised Palomar Transfer Station SWFP #37-AH-0001 will:

- Update the total tipping area of the transfer station from 19,470 ft² to 23,430 ft²;
- Update the capacity for the amount of material storage on the tipping floor from 740 tons to 1,066 tons based on increased building capacity;
- Update LEA findings; and
- Amend the Transfer Processing Report

The LEA's preliminary determination is to approve the proposed revised Solid Waste Facility Permit. The solid waste facility permit revision will not result in an increase in the permitted daily tonnage or increase the hours of operation.

This Public Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed revised SWFP and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. Within 60 days of accepting

the application package for filing and after conducting the information meeting, the LEA will forward the proposed SWFP application package CalRecycle for concurrence.
