Hello Mark and Robert,

At our noticed December 13th Boulevard Planning Group meeting, we voted 5-0-0 (2 seats vacant) to request a 30 day comment extension for Soitec's application for a Programmatic EIR GPA12-010: <http://www.sdcounty.ca.gov/pds/ceqa/GPA12-010.html>

The current January 7th deadline does not give us adequate time to properly review and provide comments for 4 large-scale projects placed in close proximity to homes, especially with the holidays and the cumulative impact projects that also require review and comment.

SolOrchard's MUP application (PDS2012-MUP-12-025) for another 70 plus acre tracking solar project, next to existing residences, just arrived in the mail along with SDG&E's notice of their Boulevard transmission line project upgrade to support proposed local tribal wind projects that total over 250-400 MW of industrial wind to be located on tribal land a--also butting private land with existing residences and small livestock operations.

Please let me know your response on the request for extension as soon as possible.
