Hello Mr. Schiff

I am providing the following information and attached documents related to CPUC DWA suspension of bulk water sales from Live Oak Springs Water Co and recent Live Oak Springs Will-Serve water availability letter:

1. Will Serve letter from Live Oak Springs Water Co, signed by Nazar Najor in December 2012
2. The Will Serve letter was presented to San Diego County staff by Soitec Solar to show they have water available to support their Major Use Permits for construction of 4 industrial scale solar projects totaling 168MW and covering almost 1,500 acres (2.34 sq miles) of our groundwater dependent community.
3. That will serve letter is marked "SDC PDS RCVD 04-16-13 REZ12-005 P12-010"
4. Dudek is / was Soitec's consultant working on Live Oak Springs Water Source Capacity Study for their 4 solar projects in Boulevard.
5. Dudek's Trey Driscoll was present at our April 4th Boulevard Planning Group meeting with Nazar Najor, and sat through some intense discussions on this issue. Driscoll and Dudek should be well aware of the CPUC DWA's suspension of water sales, violations, fines issued to Live Oak Springs Water Co.
6. May 2nd Boulevard Planning Group agenda with Soitec Solar and Live Oak Springs Water Co agenda items
7. Photograph of the two remaining construction company bulk water sales tanks that were still parked behind the Live Oak Springs restaurant as of April 29th, when I last drove through there visiting friends.
8. New cumulative energy project water impact study by Dr. V.M. Ponce, SDSU professor, dated April 30th, including 4 Soitec Solar project water use:
