FINAL MINUTES
Tuesday, MAY 22 2012

7:30 pm**

1. **Call to Order:** Michael Casinelli called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.

2. **Roll Call:**

Present: Michael Casinelli, Dan Neirinckx, Janet Mulder, Randy White, Jean Strouf, Earl Katzer, Steve Wragg, Preston Brown and Judy Bohlen.

Absent: Dale Fuller, and Yvonne Purdy-Luxton

Excused: Jonathan Shultz, Ray Deitchman, Dan Kjonogaard, and Bill Herde.

3. **Motion to approve the Agenda May 22, 2012, as posted 72 hours before the meeting and the minutes of May 8, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.**

4. **Open Forum - Opportunity for public to speak on any item not on the agenda**
 - a. **Preston Brown** read the information on the Goldspotted Oak Borer and pointed out that we could get a person from California Division Forestry, named Tom Coleman, who speaks to groups on this problem. Eradication is difficult including community awareness to stop the removal of firewood from our area and Preston suggested we invite someone to come to our Planning Group and make us a presentation. **Dan Neirinckx** suggested we book it for after the Jamul Shopper & news comes out. **Preston Brown** will attempt to get a speaker for September 11 meeting and will be responsible for writing an article and sending it to Tammy Grant before August 10 for the September issue.
 - b. **Noise Level Limitation Letter sent by Michael Casinelli to all of the Planning Group Chairs, Eric Gibson and Dianne Jacob** recognizing that the County's existing ordinance does not recognize the lower ambient noise level in the back country, and we requested a review of the noise ordinance to recognize this difference. An immediate response was received from Rainbow CPG as they have a problem with the Indian Racetrack in their area.
 - c. **Michael Casinelli, wrote a letter to Otay Water District with a copy to our representative Board Member, Mark Robak**, asking them to follow through on their landscape plan that they presented to our JDCPG when they planned it as the plants have not matured and are extremely slow growing.

5. **Bicycle Transportation Plan Recommendations** -- **Dan Neirinckx** reported that we were requested by County Staff to investigate the possibilities of bike paths in our area. Relative safe bike paths we could possibly recommend include: SR 94 from Steele Canyon High School to Otay Lakes Road/Honey Springs; Otay Lakes Road from SR94 to Pio Pico; Honey Springs Rd from SR94 to Four Corners; Lyons Valley Road to Japutal; Skyline Truck Trail from 4 Corners to Lyons Valley Road; Lyons Valley Road from SR94 to Skyline TT; Jefferson Rd from SR94 to Lyons Valley Road. Other roads may need signs to say "Bicycle Riding Not Advised". These routes would provide a looped path either through our area or around it, and would hopefully discourage bike riders from travelling

Jamul Drive, much of Lyons Valley Road and Lawson Valley Road. **Dan Neirinckx** moved we recommend possible bike paths on SR 94 from Steele Canyon High School to Otay Lakes Road/Honey Springs; Otay Lakes Road from SR94 to Pio Pico; Honey Springs Rd from SR94 to Four Corners; Lyons Valley Road 4 Corners to Japutal; Skyline Truck Trail from 4 Corners to Lyons Valley Road; Lyons Valley Road from SR94 to Skyline TT; Jefferson Rd from SR94 to Lyons Valley Road, and further discourage the use of unsafe roads by installing warning signs which would read, “Bicycle Riding Not Advised”. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Reimbursements: (MICHAEL CASINELLI RECUSED HIMSELF FOR THE FIRST MOTION:

Michael Casinelli needs reimbursement for 27 packages sent with our 12-pages of comments on the Jamul Indian Village, Draft Tribal Environmental Evaluation which totaled \$45.55 to USPS. Dan Neirinckx moved, as Acting Chair, that we approve the \$45.55 reimbursement to Michael Casinelli and will send in the paperwork. Motion passed unanimously – 8, yes; 0, No; 1 Abstained (Casinelli)

**Michael Casinelli rejoined the meeting at this point.
Randy White recused himself for the next motion.**

Randy White needs reimbursement for \$350 for Photographs of Hollenbeck Canyon from 1929 to 1974 as per recommendation by Dianne Jacob to show photographic history of the area. A compact disk of the photographs was purchased from the Cartography Department of San Diego County Department of Land Use which allows us the right to print them. Michael Casinelli moved we recommend reimbursement of the \$350 to Randy White for the CD which will be used to demonstrate the historical perspective on what existed in Hollenbeck Canyon over the years. Motion carried: 8,yes; 0, No; 1 Abstained (White)

Randy White rejoined the meeting at this point.

- 7. Jamul Indian Village Casino Update – Michael Casinelli announced that the JIV extended their comment period until May 20 which was an increase of 21 days.** When Michael asked Steve Davis why it was extended and why we were not notified, and Steve said it was “on the JIV website”. Michael received a copy of a letter sent from Congressman Duncan Hunter in opposition to the Jamul Indian Village Casino. The letter was read to the CPG and Michael told us it was submitted to the Jamul Shopper and News and will hopefully be published in the June issue. Dan Neirinckx suggested we attach Congressman Hunter’s excellent letter to these minutes and made a part of them. **Congressman Duncan Hunter’s Letter to Jamul Indian Village re DTEE is attached to this email as it is in pdf form.**
- 8. Hollenbeck Canyon Wildlife Area/Honey Springs Ranch – Randy White reported** California Fish and Game is still working through their proposal that they feel they will have completed in October after they finish collecting the data as late as September. At the next sub-committee meeting, they will hopefully look at the historical photographs and be able to get their information together for a future meeting with CFG. The sub-committee may be changing their future meeting day from Wednesday to Thursday. Watch the Final Agenda for the correct day.
- 9. JDCPG Officer’s Announcements and Reports: Jonathan Shultz was not at the meeting and we assume had nothing to report that came to our Post Office Box.**
