County Draft Equine Ordinance and Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR)  
Public Review, February 4 – March 20

The Equine Ordinance and EIR is to update the County of San Diego's Zoning Ordinance with regard to commercial equine uses, a Horse Stable according to zoning. The update was directed by the Board of Supervisors in July 2011 to develop a tiered permitting approach for the commercial Horse Stable use type. For large areas of the unincorporated area of the County, including parts of Lakeside, current codes require a Major Use Permit for a commercial Horse Stable, irrespective of the number of horses. The proposed equine ordinance introduces a series of tiers, therefore as the intensity of the commercial Horse Stable increases, so does the permit obligation.

As the project proposes to allow for ministerial permitting in areas where a discretionary permit (use permit) is currently required for a Horse Stable, the project must analyze potentially significant effects under CEQA with an EIR. The draft ordinance and draft EIR are currently on public review.
