7. Consideration of Review for Site Distance Visibility of Steffy and Ashley

Carl Hickman spoke about the importance of Raymond Street and Kelly Street that are currently at #42 on the project priority list. This area should be in our top ten list. Scott Ensign also talked about the bridge east of Etcheverry as a possible bottle neck slowing the water flow. Ms. Mansolf said when she looked at Raymond/Kelly flooding a couple of years ago, she noticed flooding in ditches all along Hunter Street, extending in the front yards of several properties. There were also many other problem areas all the way up to Boundary. T&T is requesting a letter from the RCPG to the County regarding the importance of Raymond Street, Kelly Street, Hunter Street and Ramona Street as the most important areas to be addressed. Second – send a letter to Caltrans to review the bridge east of Etcheverry on Highway 67 for proper flow.
