

San Vicente Road Improvement Project

Update #3
November 2014

On September 15, 2014 the County of San Diego Department of Public Works started the San Vicente Road Improvement Project in Ramona. The estimated project completion is Spring 2016.

Traffic Control Construction Hours

Daytime = 9:00am – 3:00pm

Nighttime = 7:00pm – 5:00am

Please note that we will continue to prioritize Northbound traffic in the morning, and Southbound traffic in the evening.

No lane closures are allowed on National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) designated "RED FLAG DAYS"

Updates

- K-rail painting, patching and reflectors complete
- No night work scheduled through 11/21
- Pilot cars being utilized as an additional safety measure for construction equipment movement
- Traffic fines will be doubled in construction zone
- Construction personnel and County staff (in coordination with Emergency Services) are developing options for adding turnouts between Deviney Lane and Wildcat Canyon in addition to restoring the left-turn movement at Warnock

Current Construction Activity

Over the next three weeks, the contractor is scheduled to perform the following activities:

- Cut and fill (including blasting)
- Clearing and Grubbing (tree and debris removal)
- Grind oak trees to prevent Oak Borer spread (see warning below)
- Grading for temporary stage 2 roadway detours
- Place double fine and radar speed feedback signs as traffic calming measures
- Upcoming temporary water shut down to relocate meters (advance notifications will be provided to affected property owners)
- Removal of SDG&E poles on East end of project

On-going Coordination

- Monthly Emergency Services Meetings with County staff, Flatiron Construction, Sheriff, CHP and CalFire will be held to plan for the minimization of traffic delays due to accidents or vehicle break-downs. The next meeting will be in early December 2014.

Bicyclists are encouraged to use an alternative route during construction. Any bicyclists on San Vicente Road during construction are reminded that you are required to share the road with motor vehicles so please use caution.
