

On September 15, 2014 the County of San Diego Department of Public Works started the San Vicente Road Improvement Project in Ramona. The estimated project completion is Spring 2016.

Traffic Control Construction Hours

Daytime = 9:00am – 3:00pm

Nighttime = 7:00pm – 5:00am

Please note that we will continue to prioritize Northbound traffic in the morning, and Southbound traffic in the evening.

No lane closures are allowed on National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) designated "RED FLAG DAYS"

Updates

- A vehicle turnout has been added between Deviney Lane and Wildcat Canyon Road.
- The rain from end of November has delayed some construction work in preparation for the restoration of the left-turn lane at Warnock.
- Construction crews will continue to prioritize the underground work required to restore the left turn lane at Warnock. Current schedule is dependent on the weather in the coming weeks.
- Oaks trees have been removed and sent to chippers
- Traffic fines will be doubled in construction zone

Current Construction Activity

Over the next three weeks, the contractor is scheduled to perform the following activities:

- Cut and fill (including rock breaking)
- Clearing and Grubbing (between Deviney and Wildcat Canyon)
- Continue grading for temporary stage 2 roadway detours
- Utility joint trench construction from Warnock to Gem Lane in preparation for restoration of left-turn at Warnock
- Form/pour/strip drainage headwalls at driveways
- Install Drainage culverts at driveways
- Drainage ditch construction (between Deviney and Wildcat Canyon)

On-going Coordination

- Monthly Emergency Services Meeting held on Thursday, December 4, 2014 with County staff, Flatiron Construction, Sheriff, CHP and CalFire to continue coordination for the minimization of traffic delays. The next meeting will be in early January 2015.

Bicyclists are encouraged to use an alternative route during construction. Any bicyclists on San Vicente Road during construction are reminded that you are required to share the road with motor vehicles so please use caution.
