

On September 15, 2014 the County of San Diego Department of Public Works started the San Vicente Road Improvement Project in Ramona. The estimated project completion is Spring 2016.

Traffic Control Construction Hours

Daytime = 9:00am – 3:00pm

Nighttime = 7:00pm – 5:00am

Please note that we will continue to prioritize Northbound traffic in the morning, and Southbound traffic in the evening. Traffic fines doubled in construction zones.

No lane closures are allowed on National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) designated "RED FLAG DAYS"

Construction progress in February 2015

- Earthwork cut and fill (including rock breaking)
- Utility joint trench construction from Warnock to Gem Lane in preparation for restoration of left-turn at Warnock. Left turn pocket anticipated in May 2015 with stage 2 traffic shift
- Continue grading for temporary stage 2 roadway detour traffic shift currently anticipated in May 2015
- Storm drain culvert installations in stage 1 working areas
- Utility joint trenching operations
- Top and toe of slope brow ditch (drainage) construction



Upcoming March 2015 Construction Activity

- Continue cut and fill earthwork operations in stage 1 working areas
- Clearing and Grubbing (between Deviney and Wildcat Canyon)
- Continue grading and construction of transitions for temporary stage 2 roadway detours
- Utility joint trench construction from Gem Lane to Deviney Lane
- New 16" waterline installation between Deviney Lane and Chuckwagon Road
- Install Drainage culverts at driveways
- Continue drainage ditch construction



On-going Coordination

- Monthly Emergency Services Meeting held on Thursday, February 11, 2015 with County staff, Flatiron Construction, Sheriff, CHP and CalFire to continue coordination for the minimization of traffic delays. The next meeting will be on March 11, 2015.
