



Walk This Way

In July and August, the County is continuing the installation of box culvert segments along Woodside Avenue and getting closer to connecting the tunnels that have been completed at the Water Quality Basin and SR 67. Crews will also install curbs and gutters this summer along the south side of Woodside Avenue, as well as crosswalks and corner ramps at the Woodside Avenue and Riverview Avenue intersection.

The installation of these pedestrian features is part of the County's efforts to update Woodside Avenue for active transportation in addition to the stormwater drainage and roadway re-paving that crews will complete. New pedestrian and bicycle features will include:

- ▶ **Sidewalks:** Crews will frame and pour 5-foot wide sidewalk segments to replace demolished sidewalks along Woodside Avenue in the project area. These sidewalks will also feature new directional signage.
- ▶ **Crosswalks and Pedestrian Ramps:** Crews will construct pedestrian curb ramps at sidewalk corners, as well as paint crosswalk stripes at the intersection of Woodside Avenue and Riverview Avenue to enhance accessibility for pedestrians.
- ▶ **Bicycle Lanes:** Crews will paint 5-foot dedicated bicycle lanes on both sides of Woodside Avenue to promote bicycle transportation. This bicycle lane will help residents in the area and students at Lakeside Middle School choose bicycles for all trips once construction is complete.

The features are coupled with others that will improve the aesthetics of the area. For example, overhead utilities were undergrounded and utility poles were removed. Additionally, landscaping was added to promote the ecological connections of the area. Look for these features as crews transition from installing the box culvert to improving the roadway.



Construction Update: Current Construction Activities

In July and August, the County is working on the following:

Water Quality Basin:

Crews are constructing a concrete barrier along the edge of the top of the culvert to create a dedicated access route for utility trucks to monitor and perform maintenance work.

SR 67 Reinforced Concrete Box Culvert:

Crews are completing the installation of the pre-cast sections of box culvert along Woodside Avenue. In addition, crews will form and pour the last cast-in-place

section of box culvert at the entrance to the water quality basin.

Pedestrian Features at Woodside Avenue and Riverview Avenue:

Crews are constructing curbs and gutters, sidewalks, pedestrian curb ramps, and driveways along the south side of Woodside Avenue. Crews are also painting crosswalks to guide pedestrians across the street.

These improvements are part of a larger movement by the County to help San Diegans live well by getting moving to improve their health. 1> Lindo Lake County Park:

This park is the recreational center for the Lakeside community and is at the east end of Woodside Avenue. The park features picnic areas, a softball field, and tennis courts for active San Diegans.

2> Lakeside River Park:

Located in Los Cocheros Creek on the north side of SR 67 from Woodside Avenue, Lakeside River Park connects 17 miles of trails between Lakeside and Santee for inter-regional hiking and bicycling that promotes the area's natural beauty.


3> Lake Jennings

Lake Jennings is a scenic treasure located to the southeast of Woodside Avenue. It is a great destination for fishing, camping, hiking, and picnicking.




