

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY
FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT ORDINANCE NUMBER 7
RELATING TO DRAINAGE FEES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego, acting
as and constituting the Board of Directors of the San Diego County
Flood Control District, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The following language is added to
Section 1.114 (c) of Ordinance Number 7 of the San Diego County
Flood Control District:

The fee rate for agricultural greenhouses shall be 25-percent
of the nonresidential rate.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
thirty (30) days after the date of its passage, and before the
expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage a summary shall
be published once with the names of the members voting for and
against the same in the San Diego Daily Transcript, a newspaper of
general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
