

Paintball Fields And Recreational Areas

The *County of San Diego Watershed Protection Program* supports businesses in their efforts to prevent pollution by offering these important Stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs).

- ! Water that is released into the streets, gutters, and storm drains in San Diego County is not treated before it reaches our local creeks, rivers, and the ocean. *These tips specific to paintball fields and recreational areas will help keep our waterways clean.*

General Requirements

- ▣ Remove or secure significant quantities of eroded soils to prevent their entering a storm drain or water way.
- ▣ Locate and mark storm drain inlets.
- ▣ Provide restroom facilities for customers.

Waterways

- ▣ Do not alter streams, creeks or other waterways for recreational use.
- ▣ Construct appropriate stream crossings and instruct customers to use them.
- ▣ Mark “out of bounds” on sections protecting streams and creeks.

- ! Releasing pollutants directly or indirectly into the storm drain system or waterways is a violation of the County’s Watershed Protection Ordinance (WPO). *Your business is required to comply with the WPO and the following minimum BMPs.*
