# PACE Eligibility

- ▶ Seniors 55 or older
- ▶ Need special care and assistance yet wish to remain in their home
- ▶ Skilled nursing level of care
- ▶ Are able to live in the community without jeopardizing their safety
- ▶ Live in our San Diego County service areas
- ▶ Medi-Cal & Medi-Cal/Medicare



# St. Paul's PACE Services Include:

- ▶ Two Centers
- ▶ Transportation
- ▶ Adult (Senior) day care services
- ▶ Primary medical and specialty care
- ▶ Prescription drug coverage
- ▶ Meals and dietary counseling
- ▶ Rehabilitation services
- ▶ Social services
- ▶ In-Home care services
- ▶ Emergency On-call Services





- ▶ Substandard options for low income Seniors
- ▶ Financial Situations
- ▶ Unstable living situations
- ▶ Not eligible for PACE without an address

# Celadon

- ▶ Downtown San Diego
- ▶ June 2015
- ▶ 63 Studios
- ▶ Mostly new enrollees
- ▶ Referrals from community agencies

- ▶ Intensive Case Management
- ▶ Furniture & Furnishings
- ▶ Building Community
- ▶ Building Trust

# What do the Participants Say?

- ▶ “I have been a victim of abuse and was homeless for 10 years. I am so happy to have a safe place. PACE has been great for me– my health is getting better.”

- ▶ “My health is better, I am happier and I have a social life now. PACE saved my life.”

- ▶ “I am no longer on the street. I am getting medical attention. I have a nice, quiet place to live.” *Beverly*
