# LTCIP Mission Statement

- To develop a comprehensive, consumer-centered, integrated continuum of care (health, social and supportive services) that maintains individual dignity, and allows consumers of long term care services to remain an integral part of their family and community life, and pools funding to minimize process and maximize resources.



# LTCIP Vision

- **Develop “system” that:**
  - provides continuum of health, social and support services that “wrap around consumer” w/prevention & early intervention focus
  - pools associated (categorical) funding
  - is consumer driven and responsive
  - expands access to and options for care



# LTCIP Vision Continued

- fairly compensates all providers w/rate structure developed locally
- engages MD as pivotal team member
- decreases fragmentation/duplication w/single point of entry, single plan of care
- improves quality & is budget neutral
- maximizes federal and state funding
- implements Olmstead Decision locally
