Regardless of which ePCR product your agency is using, all accredited, certified or authorized EMS providers (EMTs, AEMTs, Paramedics, MICNs) in San Diego County must have user accounts and each agency must designate a system administrator.



- **[NEMSIS Data Dictionary NHTSA v 3.4.0](#)** – Includes the NEMSIS 3.4.0 Overview and Summary, Table of Contents, and all Data Elements from the DEMDataSet and EMSDataSet that are marked as mandatory or required (as identified in the original NEMSIS 3.4.0 data dictionary).
- These fields will be included in the CoSD-LEMSIS demographic and ePCR elements.
- However, it is important to note that the Code List for each Data Element may be modified; therefore this document is a work in progress. Please check back for updates.
