BLS

ALS

- O₂ and/or ventilate prn

Jellyfish Sting:

- Liberally rinse with salt water for at least 30 seconds.
- Scrape to remove stinger (s) .
- Heat as tolerated (not to exceed 110 degrees).

Stingray or Sculpin Injury:

- Heat as tolerated (not to exceed 110 degrees).

Snakebites:

- Mark proximal extent of swelling and/or tenderness
- Keep involved extremity at heart level and immobile
- Remove pre-existing constrictive device

- IV SO adjust prn
- Treat pain as per Pain Management Protocol (S-173)

Note: if using heat pads, temperature not to exceed 110 degrees to prevent burn.
