



Who is eligible for the services?

■ Eligibility for Refugee Health Services:

To qualify for Refugee Health Assessment Program (RHAP) services, an individual must:

1. be a refugee, secondary migrant, granted asylee, Cuban or Haitian parolee, or victim of trafficking.
2. have relevant and valid USCIS identification documents verifying their status.
3. have arrived to San Diego County within the last 90 days.
4. be a resident in San Diego County.

Refugees are referred by their resettlement agencies. Other eligibles may be referred by other agencies.
