The next Long Term Care Integration Project (LTCIP) Quarterly Stakeholder meeting will be held on **Monday, September 30, 2013 from 9:30am to 12:00pm** in the Campus Center Chambers located in the County Operations Center at 5520 Overland Ave., San Diego, 92123.

This quarter's meeting promises to be one you should not miss! As you know, the Coordinated Care Initiative (CCI), which includes Cal MediConnect and Managed Medi-Cal Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS), will begin no earlier than April 2014. There are many questions regarding the implementation of CCI/Cal MediConnect. We have a wonderful opportunity at our September meeting to get those questions answered as we will be joined by Jaime Mulligan from Harbage Consulting, the lead consultant for the California Department of Health Care Services' supporting stakeholder engagement around the policy design and implementation for California's dual demonstration, Cal MediConnect.

Following the latest updates from the State on the CCI and Cal MediConnect, Greg Knoll, the CCI Advisory Committee and Communication Workgroup Chair, will provide the local perspective on the CCI and Cal MediConnect implementation. Both Ms. Mulligan and Mr. Knoll will be on hand to answer questions about the implementation of CCI in San Diego County.

Finally, Mr. Knoll will also provide an update on recent CCI Advisory Committee and Communication Workgroup developments and allow stakeholders an opportunity to bring forth any issues or concerns that should be addressed by either of these committees. We hope you will be able to join us for what promises to be a very informative meeting.
