



□ ER use in past year	54%	-4%

- What is a Continuum of Care (CoC)?

- CoCs are regional planning bodies that coordinate HUD housing and services funding for the homeless.

- HUD identifies four necessary components of a Continuum of Care:
 - 1) An outreach, intake and assessment system
 - 2) Emergency shelter
 - 3) Transitional housing with supportive services
 - 4) Permanent and permanent supportive housing

- Our local CoC is called the San Diego Regional Continuum of Care Council (RCCC) and Nick Macchione was recently seated as its Governance Board Vice Chair.



□ **25 Cities Effort**

- Sponsored by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness (USICH)
- Create a “Coordinated Assessment and Housing Placement System” (CAHP)
- Targets homeless veterans & chronically homeless individuals
- First 100-day pilot downtown, next community possibly North Region
