3. DETERMINATION OF MEMBERS PRESENT-Present Carl Hickman, John and Arvie Degenfelder, Jim Cooper, Scotty Ensign. Excused absence- Dawn Perfect, Cheryl Wegner, Karen Carlson. Not Excused absence- Bob Hailey

4. Corrections/Approval to the Minutes 3-24-14 Move to June 2, 2014 meeting
5. ANNOUNCEMENTS-Kristi Mansolf spoke on County's offer of grant support for pedestrian trails with existing trail plan.
6. PRESENTATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS ONLY -Lynn Hopewell 1448 San Vicente Dr. spoke on requests for sidewalks at 6<sup>th</sup> and Main St, 9<sup>th</sup> and Main St, 14<sup>th</sup> and Main St. and right turn lane at 10<sup>th</sup> and Main St. Lynn requested to be on the agenda for next T&T on June 2, 2014. Ms. Hopewell requested to be on the T&T committee. Ken Brenicky offered thanks to T&T members for voting no to Ramona St extension. Mr Brenicky passed out report to T&T members from SANDAG on the infeasibility of the proposed Ramona St extension project dated Aug 27, 2012 for our review. Joe Minervini presented a chart for a right turn lane from Musey Grade to the Highland Valley/Dye Rd intersection. His presentation intended to show a reduction in traffic congestion caused by the first phase of the south bypass from Musey Grade to Dye Rd. Mr Minervini requested to be on the agenda for the next T&T meeting on June 2, 2014
7. Consideration of Signage in the County Road Right of Way to Promote the Winery Industry in Ramona (Action) Dave Billick, VP of RVVA, publisher of RVW magazine. Mr Billick spoke regarding the needed signage on our roadways to direct people to our wineries. At this time Mr Billnick had no sign samples or locations to show T&T. Information only. Scotty Ensign request that Mr Billnick produce sample drawings to present to Design Review to show size, color and font of proposed signage. Kristi Mansolf read from the zoning ordinance 6207.B.3 regarding signage along county roads. Carl Hickman said "CALTRANS will be a fight". Mr Billnick said "Duncan Hunter, Jr. and Diane Jacobs are proponents of wineries" he will speak to RCPG at the May 1<sup>st</sup> meeting.
8. Further Revisions to the Montecito Ranch Tentative Map through the County's Map Modification Process (Action) Chris Brown discussed the construction timing summary for Montecito Ranch (TM5250) improvements. Mr Brown concedes that the list of roads are part of his requirements from the county. He was looking for T&T to allow an extended timeline for some of the street improvements and intersections. Scotty Ensign requested more information on which part of Montecito Ranch would start first. Mr Ensign had concerns over construction equipment utilizing unimproved roads and creating traffic issues. Arvie D. agreed about the construction/traffic concerns. Jim Cooper felt all of the road improvements were equally important and expressed concern that all road improvements be completed prior to

occupancy of first house on site. Carl Hickman spoke on the importance of Montecito Rd being completed prior to construction. Carl Hickman made a motion that Montecito Rd/Hwy 67 be funded prior to construction of Montecito Ranch. This makes the requirements the same as Highland Valley Rd/Dye Rd/SR-67 intersection. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim Cooper. Vote: 5 yes, 0 no, 0 abstained Motion from Jim Cooper-leave roads number 4-11 as listed under construction time 8-16-13. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scotty Ensign. Vote: 2 yes, 1 no, and 2 abstained motion failed.

9. Concerns from Members-Jim Cooper announced a clerical error to the list of roads to be resurfaced that were approved by the RCPG at last month's meeting. The error-the following roads need to be added to complete the list of ten roads; from Hunter St from Kelly St to San Diego Ave. Scotty Ensign reported that as a part of the Ad-hoc committee he agrees with this clerical error. Scotty Ensign reported the need for Letters of Intent for T&T subcommittee members.
