- Qualified Kumeyaay cultural monitors are on site at all time
  Give frequent up-dates to the tribes and final report on findings
- Immediately contact Viejas on any changes or inadvertent discoveries

## **Response to Comment Letter T1**

## Viejas Band of Kumeyaay Indians May 6, 2015

T1-1 Section 2.3, Cultural Resources, of the DEIR, discusses the Project's potential impacts to cultural and archaeological resources, including Native American resources. Both the Project Archaeologist and County staff have conducted outreach (Sacred Lands check) with the Viejas Band and to date no information related to Sacred Sites (type of site, location) has been provided. It is assumed that Viejas may be referring to sites that contain human remains. Consultation with the Most Likely Descendant Kumeyaay (MLD) – Cultural Repatriation Committee (KCRC) took place upon discovery of the human remains. The MLD took possession of the human remains and associated grave goods. All areas containing human remains will be avoided through project design which will include a buffer zone. A cultural survey and significance testing was conducted and it has been determined that there are cultural resources on site.

Cultural mitigation measures (M-CR-1) requires the implementation of an archaeological monitoring program that will include a Kumeyaay Native American monitor. All project conditions were provided for review during public review of the

DEIR. The commenter did not identify any inadequacies with the conditions. The project complies will all applicable laws and regulations. AB-52 does not apply because public review for the DEIR began prior to July 1, 2015. Should Federal permits be required, the National Environmental Policy Act and the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act will apply to the Project. Project conditions have been revised to include communication with the Viejas Tribal Government throughout Project implementation.

The balance of comments are not at variance with the environmental document. The environmental document (M-CR-1, M-CR-2) has been revised based upon these comments.
