Please be advised that a survey has been conducted on the above referenced project. It has been determined that there are no cultural resources present on this property. The project has been plotted on the attached USGS 7.5 minute topographical map for your information.

Description: The field survey was conducted using standard archaeological procedures and techniques. Continuous parallel transects (5-10 meters) were walked in a North/South direction. Survey conditions were excellent, with only the western boundary partially obscured by ground cover in the form of non-native vegetation. There was excessive rodent disturbance on the eastern portion of the project area and the back dirt was inspected for cultural resources with negative results. No artifacts or features of any kind were identified during this survey. This project proposes to subdivide an existing lot into three parcels.

Prior Research: Staff conducted a records search of the surrounding area using the California Historic Resources Inventory System (CHRIS). Thirteen studies have been conducted within a one mile radius; none of these covered the subject property. As a result of these studies four sites, one prehistoric and three historic were identified. The site(s) are within one mile from the subject property. P-37-027644 a 1933 single family residence, P-37-027643 a 1947 residential structure, and P-37-018184 a 1935 vernacular cottage. The prehistoric site, CA-SDI-00622 is a small bedrock milling site which was reported as being mostly destroyed.


