



**SAN DIEGO COUNTY

1943 Under Supervision
October 15, 2012**

Public Safety Realignment, or AB109, changed who supervises certain released prisoners. Post Release Offenders (PROs), are now supervised by the Probation Department rather than by state parole. The legislation also created a population of Mandatory Supervision Offenders, or MSOs. These offenders may receive a "split" sentence, meaning a portion of their time is completed in local custody and the balance under mandatory probation supervision.




Committing Offense Type
