In addition, all sub-recipients requesting funds for programs working directly or indirectly with homeless populations will be required to participate in the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) database effort administered by the Regional Task Force on the Homeless. Although you may not be able to fill in all the requested information, please provide as much information as possible.

Please note that if you are applying for funds on behalf of a community organization and intend to directly implement a project, you must fill out the CDBG Application for Community Organizations instead of this request form. CDBG community organization applications and resident request forms can also be downloaded from the County website at www.sdhcd.org (select 'Community Development' from home page, then select Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), and then select 'CDBG Video Presentations'. The applications are located at the bottom of the page.). The application must be submitted to Housing and Community Development Services by the application deadline of 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 27, 2017.
