

I am opposed to all four of the solar projects as described in the Soitec Solar PIER. As a resident in the area, I enjoy the unobstructed views of the mountains and open valleys which will be destroyed by this project. I have seen the solar project along Interstate 8 West of Gila Bend and the effect that that project has on the landscape. This project will upset the natural environment and have a negative impact on the adjacent residents' quality of life and their property values. As an officer of the Pine Valley Fire Protection District, I am concerned about the placement of this huge solar project in an area that is prone to wildfire and that has limited firefighting capabilities. We have a limited aquifer in the area which will be further reduced by millions of gallons of water taken out of our Pine Valley aquifer.

For the above reasons, I support the NO PROJECT alternative listed in the Soitec PIER.
