



Description: An archaeological field survey was conducted by Gail Wright and Scott Mattingly on the Lang property in the San Dieguito CPG area. The survey was negative: no historic or prehistoric cultural artifacts or features were observed in the areas surveyed. A large portion of the parcel is difficult to access because of areas of dense Diegan Coastal Sage scrub vegetation (Holland No. 32500) and in other areas a thick covering of non-native grassland. The accessible areas were surveyed along game trails and dirt roadways. The soils observed in clearings and from rodent activity appeared to be mostly light tan, decomposed granitic soils. No midden soils were

observed. The ground was littered throughout with mostly small, cracked granitic rocks, none of which appeared to be the size or material common to prehistoric milling features. Although much of the site was difficult to survey, enough of the open, flat areas and some of the drainages and slopes provided enough open space and adequate ground visibility to allow for the determination of negative survey results.
