


Description: The field survey was conducted using standard archaeological procedures and techniques. To the extent feasible, continuous parallel transects spaced less than 10 m apart were walked in the direction of the ridge line. The steeper slopes of the ridge were contoured, so that all areas were walked. The existing access road to the knoll top was also surveyed. Survey conditions in these areas were good, with some areas partially obscured by vegetative cover. Some grading has been done on the knoll top in the past to accommodate two existing water tanks and associated features. No artifacts or features were identified during this survey. Therefore, no impacts to cultural resources are anticipated.


USGS Topographical Map - Cuyamaca Peak quadrangle
